Arts Landing,

a new outdoor civic space envisioned by the Pittsburgh Cultural Trust and designed by renowned landscape architecture firm Field Operations, is one of the most transformative projects in the Cultural District in 25 years. The creatively designed and community focused 4-acre destination welcomes residents and visitors, hosts festivals and performances, exhibits public art and provides opportunities for recreation and relaxation.



*** PUBLIC ART.** Slow down, look closer and discover something new with every visit. Distinct artworks are integrated across the site, transforming paths, gathering places, and open views into moments of reflection, play and connection. Installations will rotate every 12-36 months.

*** GREAT LAWN.** The heart of Arts Landing is a 1-acre, gently sloping great lawn. The gorgeous green space centers the Allegheny River and two of the Three Sisters bridges, welcoming pedestrians from multiple entrances.

*** DOLLAR BANK STAGE.** Long-term home for Cultural Trust festivals. The canopy design of the stage preserves the flowing aesthetics of Arts Landing, providing a state-of-the-art performance space for entertainers.
